The Consumer Culture Theory Consortium provides a grant of **USD 5,350** to cover full or partial seminar fees for applicants from the Global South.

Applicants must meet the following criteria:

- Accepted for the seminar.
- Affiliation with a home institution in the Global South, as defined by the Consumer Culture Theory Consortium (see regional eligibility and exclusions below).

Eligible regions include:

Latin America and the Caribbean (excluding the USA and Canada); Africa; and Asia (including Türkiye), **except for the following high-income countries:** China, Japan, the Republic of Korea (South Korea), Israel, Saudi Arabia, the United Arab Emirates, Qatar, Bahrain, Kuwait, and Asian Russia. Applications will be assessed by the seminar organizers.
